If for some reason a recipient will not enroll in school for the term when the scholarship is to commence, he or she will be required to return the awarded funds. The scholarship will not be limited to tuition and books exclusively, but may be used for expenses arising out of the recipient's enrollment in college or university. Scholarship awards will be paid through the student's college or university. Proof of enrollment must be submitted to the scholarship chair prior to the disbursement of funds.

No eligible applicant will be denied the scholarship because of race, sex, and color, national, or ethnic origin.
