The scholarships become effective with the full-time enrollment of the succeeding quarter or semester. If for some reason a recipient will not be returning to school for the term when the scholarship is to commence, he or she will be required to return the awarded funds. The scholarship will not be limited to tuition and books exclusively, but may be used for expenses arising out of the recipient's enrollment in college or university. Scholarship awards will be paid through the student's college or university. Proof of enrollment must be submitted to the scholarship chair prior to the disbursement of funds.

No eligible applicant will be denied the scholarship because of race, sex, and color, national, or ethnic origin.

Qualifications:

All applicants for the Texas CattleWomen Collegiate Scholarship must be an Agricultural Major at a Texas College or University and meet eligibility requirements.

Eligibility:

- Classification: Sophomore through senior level in a Texas 4 year college or university.
- Resident: Must be a resident of the state of Texas and a graduate of a Texas High School or the equivalent thereof.
- Major: Any Agricultural Major
- Grade Point: 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Evidence of being a well balanced individual, considering physical, mental, and social development. Must have a pleasing personality and the ability to relate well with others. Must have high moral standards.
- Financial need explained.
- Evidence of potential for continuing education.
- Participation in student activities and evidence of leadership qualities.
- Must have an interest in, and a willingness to support the production and consumption of beef.

Texas CattleWomen Scholarship Rules – Collegiate CattleWomen: \$1,000

Qualifications:

All applicants must be a collegiate CattleWomen member and meet all eligibility requirements.

Eligibility:

- Membership: Applicant must be a current Texas CattleWomen member at the time of application, and should also have been a paid member of TCW the year prior to application as well. The scholarship chair will verify membership eligibility with the TCW membership chair.
- Classification: Sophomore through senior level in a Texas 4 year college or university
- Resident: Must be a resident of the state of Texas and a graduate of a Texas High School or the equivalent thereof.
- Major: Any Agricultural Major
- Grade Point: 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Evidence of being a well balanced individual, considering physical, mental, and social development. Must have a pleasing personality and the ability to relate well with others. Must have high moral standards.
- Financial need explained.
- Evidence of potential for continuing education.
- Participation in student activities, CattleWomen activities and evidence of leadership qualities.

All applicants for the IGOE Collegiate Scholarship must come from an agricultural background in the beef industry and be returning to the beef industry after graduation and meet the eligibility requirements.

- Classification: College level, junior or above, including graduate students in a Texas 4 year college or university.
- Resident: Must be a resident of the state of Texas and a graduate of a Texas High School or the equivalent thereof.
- Major: any degree in a beef industry related field
- Grade point: 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Evidence of being a well balanced individual, considering physical, mental, and social development. Must have a pleasing personality and the ability to relate well with others. Must have high moral standards.
- Financial need explained.
- Evidence of potential for continuing education.
